Remember that typhoon is a weather phenomenon that no one can prevent from occurring. However, what we can do is to prepare and help prevent the destruction brought about by these weather disturbances.

How to Prepare for the Typhoon Season

Consider the following to protect yourself and your belongings during the typhoon season:

- ▶ Always listen to the warning forecasts on TV and radio to learn about the location and strength of the typhoon.
- ▶ Make sure your home is sturdy enough to endure potential gusty winds and flash floods. Board up windows and doors if necessary, and strap down or secure loose objects around the house that can be picked up by strong winds.
- ▶ If you feel that your house is not secure enough or you are told to evacuate, then do so immediately. Don't wait until the winds are very strong, which could make evacuating dangerous.
- ▶ Purchase enough emergency supplies for all family members for at least three days, such as food, drinking water, gas, medicine, etc. Groceries and markets might not be able to resume operations after a typhoon, so make sure your supplies would last until the situation goes back to normal.
- ▶ During the typhoon, the local utility firm may voluntarily cut off the electric supply so flashlights, batteries and candles will be necessary. You may opt to put off electricity within your home to prevent any electrical accidents.
- ▶ Typhoons bring in rains and winds so make sure you have jackets and umbrellas, in case you may need to flee.
- ▶ If your home is safe enough, just stay indoors before and during the typhoon to ensure safety. Electric wires might fall down to the streets and compromise safety during typhoons. The same goes for falling, or even flying objects, which are the usual cause of injuries and casualties.
- ▶ Monitor news updates regarding the typhoon. Get battery-operated radios to make sure that you'll always be informed in case the electric and communication facilities shut down.
